



**A suggested guide to breeding:** Sexual receptivity and hemorrhagic discharge are not trustworthy. Instead, vaginal cytology should be monitored. When cornification is obvious for the first time, perform serum assays for progesterone every second day. When progesterone increases > 2ng/ml, measure LH that day and in serum from the day before. Breeding should occur on days 4 and 6 after the LH surge or once (surgical A.I.) on day 5.
